7. Bareec App

Evolution of Bareec



About Bareec

Launched in 2016/2017, **Bareec** Project for Positive Thinking & Wellbeing is an educational program that trains teachers how to implement fun and interactive positivity exercises in the classroom to empower students with the benefits of positive thinking.

Designed by Alnowair, a non-profit initiative driven to bring positive social behavioral change to Kuwait, **Bareec** takes inspiration from scientific research and work done in the field of positive psychology from around the world, and trains teachers on how to implement the program in their respective schools.

Positive Affirmations were initially implemented in 2015/2016 in 3 schools, although after an encouraging impact upon students and teachers alike, later improved and expanded to 13 schools in 2016/2017.

By the beginning of 2018/2019 academic year, **Bareec** trained 275 teachers and was being implemented in 36 schools across Kuwait outreaching 8000 students.

Since 1/4/2018, **Bareec** is officially under the umbrella of the 5-year development plan in collaboration with the Ministry of Education. **Bareec** lies under the **Human Development Theme of the "New Kuwait 2035"** Project,





which is sponsored by the Supreme Council for Planning and Development in the State of Kuwait.

The activities of **Bareec** focus on many values, most notably gratitude. Researchers have found that 40% of the contentment is due to expressing gratitude towards things in our lives; making life more joyful and happy.

High school students are the main focus of the program; however, **Bareec** impacts all those who deal with it, either school administratives, educational bodies or parents. There have been many occasions where they credit the program for bringing more positivity in their own personal lives.

- A series of 6 booklets, each consists of a guide for the teacher and a booklet for the student.
- In 2018/2019, approximately 6,000 students applied parts one and two of the booklet series, and approximately 2,000 students applied parts 3 and 4 of the series.
- Detailed content in each booklet describes everything users need, both teachers and students.
- 10 interactive & innovative exercises in each part of **Bareec** Booklets.
- · One exercise is implemented per week with clearly defined goals and tasks.

 Supporting booklets are provided to help both teacher and student to understand positivity in a simple yet scientific way.

 About 8.000 students and 275 teachers use Bareec Notebook (My Bright Thoughts) in 2018/2019.

- World class interactive & innovative training courses are offered to teachers.
- Attractive environment takes into consideration the training needs of the teachers.
- In 2016/2017, **60 teachers** from 13 schools were trained

- In 2017/2018, around 120 teachers from 24 schools were trained.
- In 2018/2019, about 275 teachers from **36 schools** were trained
- All teachers are trained twice in each academic year.

 To evaluate for the purpose of upgrading the program, 2 seminars are organized in each academic year to interact and respond to the opinion of the teachers.

• Supervising team carry out field visits to schools throughout the academic year to ensure implementation according to the objectives of the program.

• Bareec clubs, furnished colorfully, attract students towards specifically designed club activities supplementing the program, and encourage them to adopt the principles of positive thinking with ease.

Bareec Booklets

• The curriculum has been prepared by experts in the field of positive psychology.

• **Bareec** consists of a set of booklets (Part I to Part VI). Each part consists of a teacher's guide and a student's workbook, both in Arabic and English.

• The booklets include a range of innovative, interactive yet simple activities based on proven scientific research in the field of positive psychology. • One activity is carried out per week, and is repeated on a daily basis.

• Research has proven that the repetition of short and simple activities, makes a significant positive behavioral change difference and can be scientifically measured.

• Activities can be carried out inside and outside the classroom, during and after the school day.

Positivity 101 Manual

Contains a collection of scientific articles from the field of positive psychology, classified into: what is positivity, the benefits of positivity, and how to be positive.

The booklet is both in Arabic and English, and targets the teaching staff to enhance their knowledge about Positive Psychology and its benefits.



My Bright Thoughts Notebook

A notebook in both Arabic and English, features simple exercises and activities through daily practices to help shift the users' minds to become more positive.







Bareec Club Activities Booklet

A booklet that contains a collection of simple and creative activities that are implemented in **Bareec** clubs at schools.



Bareec Award Evaluation Form

A brochure that contains a set of criteria on which to choose the outstanding schools in achieving the objectives of **Bareec**.

This form is distributed at the beginning of the year so schools have knowledge of the goals they have to reach to achieve the prize.





Local Training Courses:

Bareec program commences by training the teaching staff participating in the program by introducing them to the literature of positive psychology. The teaching staff then practice the exercises to better understand and learn their effects, before

implementing them on students.

First Class halls are now used to host the implementation of the training courses to ensure attractive and comfortable environment for increasing numbers of **Bareec** teachers.

Training # 1 usually takes place in September of each academic year on the set of activities to be implemented in the first semester.

To ensure the implementation and the desried educational return of the program, a team of educators follow up with schools and listen closely to students, parents, teachers and school administratives about **Bareec**.

Field visits are conducted, at least twice per semester for each school.

Bareec Club

In each school there is a **Bareec** Club.

The club is decorated in an attractive way utilizing **Bareec** colors; orange, yellow, gray and white.

The walls are painted with the colors, logo and doodles of **Bareec**.

The club is where **Bareec** teams hold meetings, and students participate in activities.

All club activities promote the adoption of positive thinking behaviors.







Bareec's App for Smart Phones (IOS and Android)

Smartphone application is available in both **Arabic** and **English**.

App users are: Students, Teachers, Bareec Team Leaders, Educators, and the Admin.

The application contains a set of exercises. The more students play, the higher scores they get, which might qualify them to win an award at the end of the year.



Scientific Research

- Bareec conducted and commissioned its own scientific research following international scientific and ethical standards; entitled "Wellbeing Matters in Kuwait: The Alnowair's Bareec Education Initiative". The results of the study have demonstrated the impact of the program on changing the behaviors of target groups. The research has been published in Springer Magazine, one of the best scientific research journals.
- Faisal Al Enezi from Mohammed Al Muhaini High School in Jahraa Educational Area, wrote his master's thesis on the impact of Bareec.
- In collaboration with Kuwait University, there are future plans for conducting other scientific researches from different perspectives on the validity of **Bareec** in achieving social emotional behavioral change.





The demand for the study of pure science subjects with passion: The program gives a chance for all subjects teachers (Kuwaiti and Non-Kuwaiti) to participate in **Bareec**, offering them necessary training to get acquainted to the objectives and mechanisms of **Bareec**. This made the lessons of pure mathematics, physics and chemistry an attractive field for students.





- Increase in students' confidence and their ability to overcome tension especially during the exams, as some mothers reported at Adan High school for Girls in Mubarak Al Kabeer Educational Area.
- Change in the behavior of the educational body involved with Bareec. Remarkable desired atmosphere and relationship among the administration and Bareec teachers.
- 13 The remarkable decrease in discontent rates among students. Parents have noticed that in the behavior of their children.

14 Lubna Bent Al Hareth High School for Girls in Ahmadi Educational Area submitted an extensive report supported by Social Services Office and Vice Principal Office in the school demonstrating the impact of **Bareec** in **reducing negative behaviors and absenteeism**, **maintaining public property, and creating a positive school environment with the cooperation of all**.

- Salman Al Farsi High School for Boys in Farwaniya Educational Area has reported the impact of **Bareec** in **solving students' problems** and the ability to **control violence** in the school collaborating with the Social Worker Office, and **higher rates of success** in the subjects. **Bareec classes are the best among all classes** as teachers report.
- 16 Ahmed Al Robei High School for Boys in Hawalli Educational Area report refers to the **elimination of negative thoughts and frustration among the students** as they become more aware of the importance of learning for a brighter future. The report emphasizes the increase in success rates, and the decrease in violence rates.








Salah El Din High School for Boys is referring to the existence of the usual school student problems; it often does not exacerbate because of Bareec. Also, they noticed that students started to encourage each other to change their behavior. According to the Social Service Office in the school, a decrease in the number of students' issues has been observed and the students' calmness prevailed at the school environment.

- 18 The report of Mishref High School for Girls in Hawalli Educational Area, points that the students who participated in Bareec achieved 100% rates of success, with a high rate of excellent outreached to 70%.
- 19 The participating teachers became more creative in presenting scientific material as Bayan High School for Girls

in Hawalli Educational Area, report showed.

20 Awatef Al Athbi High School for Girls in Ahmadi Educational Area has applied short survey for the students to see the impact of the progress of Bareec. The results showed that the behavior of some students did change, increase in desire and attention to study, discipline in school, the change of school behaviors to positive, decrease in school rules violations compared to the beginning of the first semester, decrease of delay rates in the morning, attending the classes and higher rates of maintaining school property. Also, confidence and motivation have been boosted in the students and now they say "We can overcome problems and see the bright side".
